

## **Howell Township Middle School Physical Education Grading Policy and Participation Rubric**

The Howell Township Middle school's grading guidelines are based on the New Jersey Core Curriculum Content Standards. The Standards are as follows:

### **Health**

- 2.1 Wellness
- 2.2 Integrated Skills
- 2.3 Drugs and Medicines
- 2.4 Human Relationships and Sexuality

### **Physical Education**

- 2.5 Motor Skill Development
- 2.6 Fitness

**Each student will be assessed according to the following criteria:**

#### **Daily Grade**

(Students can achieve up to five points per day for their participation during activities)

5 points	Prepared for class and performs at a high level for the entire activity with no prompting needed
4 points	Prepared for class and performs at a high level for the majority of the activity with no prompting needed
3 points	Prepared for class and performs at a consistent level for the majority of the activity with minimal prompting
2 points	Prepared for class and performs at a minimal level for the duration of the activity with minimal prompting
1 point	Prepared for class and performs at a minimal level for the duration of the activity and needs constant prompting
0 points	Unprepared for class or chooses not to participate in the class activity at all.

#### **Fitness Assessments**

(Students can achieve up to ten points per test for their participation in the physical education fitness assessments)

10 points	Performs at the advanced proficient level for the district developed fitness assessment
9 points	Performs at the proficient level for the district developed fitness assessment
7 points	Performs at the partially proficient level for the district developed fitness assessment
0 points	Unprepared for class or chooses not to participate in the assessment

#### **Teacher Assessments**

(Students can achieve points toward their grade from written and performance exams)

#### **HPE Grading Scale**

Trimester grades are determined by the following procedure:

1. **Daily Grade/Fitness Assessments/Teacher Assessments:** Adding up the total points achieved and dividing by the total points possible for overall grade.
